

C. H. Phillips offered the dedication prayer, Supt. Powell gave the right hand of fellowship and Rev. E. S. Shaw gave the charge to the church. A collection of \$30 was taken which pays for finishing the tower and leaves the church free from debt. The church is the outgrowth of some missionary extension work done by Rev. E. S. Shaw, when pastor at Cooperstown. The first visit being made in the summer of '99 when a service was held in the dining room of the Land Co., House before any buildings were built on the townsite. Later Messrs. Shaw and Gimblett held revival services preaching in the school house, depot and Alfson's store. A Sunday school was organized and a list started for a church organization. The work has been followed up by different ministers and is now in charge of Rev. T. H. Derrick. A small parsonage has been erected near the church.
