

At a meeting held at Cooperstown on the 2d day of January, 1906, for the purpose of organizing an Old Settlers Association for Griggs and Steele counties, North Dakota, Knud Thompson was elected temporary chairman and Martin A. Ueland temporary secretary. On motion the president was empowered to call a meeting for permanent organization, such meeting to be held at the courthouse in Cooperstown on January 13th inst., at 2 p. m., and to have notice of such meeting published in the local papers.
