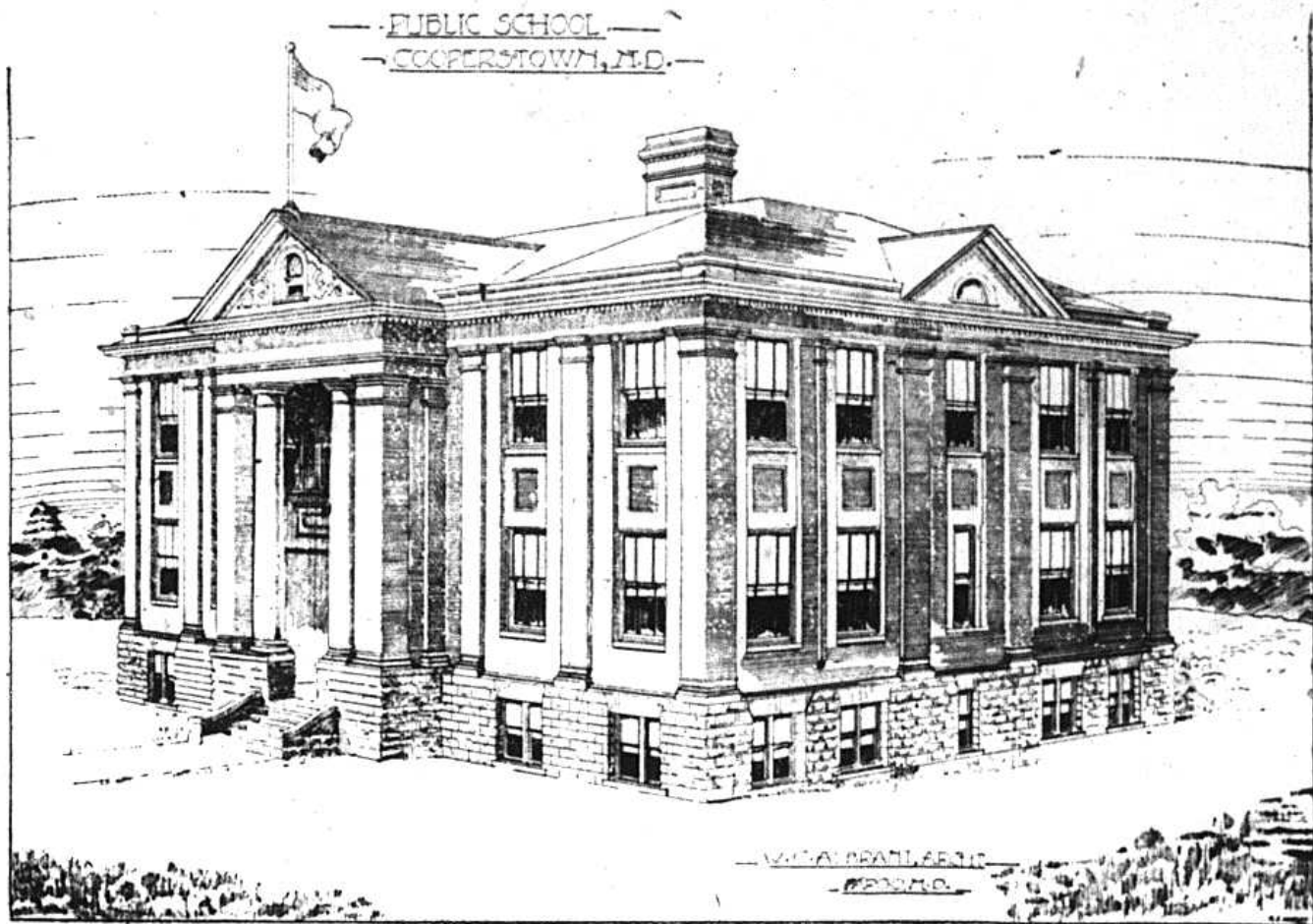


OUR NEW SCHOOLHOUSE



The COURIER presents to its readers this week a cut of Cooperstown's new educational institution now in the course of construction. As will be seen by the cut the building is a very neat and attractive one and when completed will be one of the best school buildings in North Dakota. The plans and specifications were prepared by Architect W. C. Albrant, of Fargo, and in this case he has sustained his reputation as a clever architect. Mr. Albrant has combined durability

with neatness in his plans for this building and the rooms will be large and airy, well lighted and ventilated. The board of education has certainly selected a building for the district that will meet with the approval of all persons interested in a good high school at this place. They have used much care in arranging all the details for this modern institution. There will be eight rooms in the building with play rooms, etc., in the basement. The interior will be finished off

in the best manner and when completed the citizens of the town will have occasion to feel proud of its high school building. The cost will be about \$22,000. In addition to having a good building we are fortunate in having a first class corps of teachers and those who are figuring on sending their children to school next term, can rest assured that we shall have as good a high school as can be found anywhere around here.
