

DATES ARE SETTLED

Cities of Casselton and Cooperstown Were Admitted as Members.

**ALL OF THE TOWNS
GUARANTEE \$2,000**

Valley City N. D., Feb. 6.—The annual meeting of the Central Racing Circuit of North Dakota, concluded its business by the election of officers for the ensuing year. George Day of this city, was succeeded in the presidency by J. D. Connor of Fessenden, and H. M. Tucker of Courtney succeeded himself as secretary and treasurer. C. Wing of Carrington, was made first vice president and W. E. Lane of Harvey, second vice president. The next annual meeting will be fixed by the executive committee consisting of the officers.

The all important matter before the association, the naming of dates, was determined. Valley city drew July 7, 8, 9 and 10, her regular dates, which means that the county fair will be held the week beginning July 6 and ending July 11.

Casselton and Cooperstown were admitted as members of the association, while Kensel was dropped.

All of the towns guaranteed to the horsemen purses of not less than \$2,000. They also guaranteed two class stakes, a 2:30 trot and a 2:25 pace, the purses to be either \$400 or \$500.

The dates were fixed as follows: (Fargo is not a member of the circuit, but her dates were left open.)

Casselton, June 3 and 4.

Fargo, June 16, 17 and 18.

Carrington, June 23, 24 and 25.

Wimbledon, June 29, 30 and July 1.

Cooperstown, July 3 and 4.

Valley City, July 7, 8, 9 and 10.

Jamestown, July 21, 22 and 23.

Fessenden, 25, 26 and 27.

New Rockford, July 28, 29 and 30.

Harvey, Aug. 4, 5 and 6.
