

Officers Salaries.

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARIES OF OFFICERS.

Be it enacted by the City Council:

Section 1—That the officers of the City of Cooperstown shall receive as salaries to be paid semi-annually, the amounts as follows to-wit:

Mayor, the sum of \$100 per annum;

City Treasurer, the sum of \$85 per annum;

City Auditor, the sum of \$200 per annum;

City Attorney, the some of \$100 per annum;

City Assessor, the sum of \$125 per annum, payable July 1st of each year;

Alderman the sum of \$2 per meeting;

Chief of police, the sum of \$90 per month payable monthly, said sum to cover payment for his services as Street Commissioner and for taking care of fire apparatus and other tools belonging to the city.

Night watch the sum of \$75 per month, payable monthly;

Police Magistrate and City Justice shall receive the same fees as provided by law of this state for township justices.

Section 2—This ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its approval, and said salaries shall commence on the first day of February, A. D., 1907.
