

Word was received from Fargo Saturday morning of the death of the little six year old son of Mr. and Mrs. L. M. Summerville which occurred at 4 o'clock on Friday afternoon. For a week or ten days the little boy had been sick, first with symptoms of pneumonia, then later turning into appendicitis. Dr. Darrow, of Fargo, was called, who suggested that he be taken to Fargo and placed in the hospital where he could be operated upon and properly cared for. The poor little fellow's strength was not sufficient to undergo the operation so it was not performed and he died as stated. He was an exceptionally bright little boy and was the idol of his parents. Their loss is indeed great and the sympathy of many friends goes out to them in their bereavement. The funeral was held at the residence last Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock, Rev. V. H. Ruring officiating. The remains were interred in the cemetery.
