

Death of Sven Loge.

Sven Loge died at his home in this city last Friday morning at about 3:20 from an attack of paralysis of the bowels, after being sick about two weeks. The day previous it was thought that he had made a turn for the better but the improvement was only of a temporary nature. The deceased was one of the early settlers of Griggs county, coming here from Norway with his family in 1881, and settling on a farm in Sverdrup township, where he has since resided. He has of late years been getting in such shape that he was able to rent his farm and built a home in town where he expected to take life a little easier. He was about 55 years old and leaves in addition to his wife, four sons and three daughters to mourn the loss of husband and father. The funeral was held Saturday, Rev. Josephson conducting the services, a short service being held at the house in town and regular services being held in the Sverdrup church, the remains being laid to rest in the cemetery at that place. Mr. Loge was a genial man and a good citizen and has many friends who deeply sympathize with the bereaved family in their great loss.
