

Mrs. Rood Dead.

Ragnel Olisa Rood, aged 25 years, 5 months and 5 days, died Monday, April 2, 1906, of tuberculosis, after an illness of about nine months. The deceased was born at Mount Vernon, Wis., October 28, 1880, and moved to Lake Mills, Iowa, with her parents in 1892; where she resided until her marriage to Martin Rood, of Coopers-town, on June 15, 1904. To them was born a daughter April 6, 1905. Mrs. Rood was in fair health up to the birth of their child, but soon after that event her health began to fail and she gradually grew worse until about three months ago when she was obliged to take to her bed. Since then it has only been a question of time when death would relieve her suffering. Mrs. Rood was a member of the Lutheran church and an earnest worker in the interest of christianity, and the church as well as the community loses a valuable member by her death. The funeral was held yesterday afternoon at 1 o'clock in the Lutheran church, the Revs. Voldal and Harriss officiating, the remains being shipped to the old home in Iowa for interment. The bereaved husband and daughter and other relatives have the deep sympathy of everyone in this community in their great loss.
