

## OBITUARY

Chr. Hoffard, of Lakeville near Farmington, Minn., died suddenly of hemorrhage of the stomach last Monday night, Sept. 14, at the home of Mr. and Mrs. Chas. Nelson south of Walum. Mr. Hoffard attended the services in the St. Olav church at Walum, Sunday forenoon and was apparently in good health. Monday morning hemorrhage set in, and although the doctors did all they could for him he passed away that night. He had suffered for a long while from cancer.

Deceased was about 64 years of age, resided on a farm near Lakeville, Minn., was a member of the Lutheran congregation of Rev. N. A. Quammen of Farmington, and was a kind, quiet and unassuming man. His daughter, Mrs. Adolph Kelson of Mabel township, was notified Monday of his serious illness and arrived in time to be present at her father's death-bed.
