The wrecking of a Soo passenger train at St. Paul, Monday forenoon, brings the sad intelligence that the one fatality befell a relative of Mr. and Mrs. C. A. Cross of this place. The one person killed in the wreck was Mrs. Clara Norton Cross, widow of Captain Judson N. Cross, who served with the union army during the Civil war. Mr. Cross was a brother of Mr. G. P. Cross of McHenry, which made Mrs. Cross an aunt of C. A. Cross by marriage. Mr. Cross of McHenry received a message Monday summoning him to Minneapolis as a result of the accident and he departed on the afternoon train for that city.
