

## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

In accordance with Section 2353 Chapter 29, of the Civil Code of North Dakota, we, the undersigned, a regularly elected Board of Inspectors have on this 6th day of March A. D., 1906, apportioned the Village of Binford, in Griggs County, State of N. Dakota as follows:

### DISTRICT NO. 1

Shall be that portion of said village bounded on the North by the north line of the sw $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8 Twp. 147 Range 60, on the East by the east line of the sw $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8 Twp. 147 Range 60, on the West by the center line of Whinnery Street, on the South by the N. P. R. R.

### DISTRICT NO. 2

Shall be all that portion of said village bounded on the North by the north line of the sw $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8 Twp. 147 Range 60, on the East by the center line of Whinnery Street, on the South by the N. P. R. R., on the West by the west line of the sw $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8 in Twp. 147 Range 60.

### DISTRICT NO. 3

Shall be all that portion of said village, bounded on the North by the N. P. R. R. and south line of the sw $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 8 Twp. 147 Range 60, on the East by the east line of the nw $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 17 Twp. 147 Range 60 to a point 60 rods south of the north-east corner of the nw $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 17 Twp. 147 Range 60, thence west 160 rods to a point 60 rods south of the north-west corner of the nw quarter of Sec. 17 Twp. 147 Range 60, thence north on the west line of the nw quarter of Sec. 17 and sw quarter of Sec 8 to the N. P. R. R.
