
Ordinance for License of Dogs.

Under Sec. 2365, Par. 5.

It is hereby ordered by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Binford, that an annual license fee or tax of one dollar for every male dog and two dollars for every female dog be assessed and collected for every dog owned or kept in said village of Binford that the person or persons owning or keeping any dog in said village shall procure from the marshal of said village by paying the tax aforesaid, a license and tag on or before the 15th day of June of each and every year, and that said tag so procured shall be placed and kept on said dog and which license shall be good for one year.

It is further ordered that the marshal of said Village of Binford shall immediately after the 15th day of June of each year or at any time thereafter take into his possession any dog or dogs found in said village without said tag as aforesaid, and safely keep for a period of at least one day, that upon the expiration of said one day if no one appears and claims said dog or dogs and pays the tax or license and procures a tag therefor, the said marshal shall dispose of said dog or dogs so taken as aforesaid in such a manner as to permanently remove them from the Village of Binford.
