

It now seems a certainty that Binford is to have a new depot. The material was ordered about two weeks ago, and Superintendent Burt, while on a trip over this line recently assured President Jackson of the commercial club that the matter had received favorable consideration at the hands of the railroad company, and that we were to get the long desired depot. We are informed that the new depot will be of the same model as the one at McHenry, which will make it a very neat structure.
