

# Sidewalk Ordinance

It is hereby ordered, that all new sidewalks hereafter built along Whinnery Street in the Village of Binford, Griggs County, North Dakota, on the east side of Block Six, on the east side of Block Three, on the west side of Block Five, and on the west side of Block Four, be made and constructed of cement material and of a uniform width of ten feet, the same to be up to the grade established by the county surveyor, plans of which can be seen at the office of the village clerk. The said walks are to be laid and constructed in accordance with an ordinance duly passed on August 5, 1906, by the village board. The owners of the respective lots along which said walks are to be built are hereby notified to have the same constructed in accordance with the said ordinance within two weeks from August 23, 1906, the date of the last publication of this notice, and that if they fail so to do the same will be constructed by the village of Binford and the costs and expenses of same assessed, and taxed against said lots.
