BAD FIRE AT ANETA.

\$6,000 Goes Up in Smoke Last Saturday.

Fire which started in the Moulton poolroom from unknown origin at 4 o'clock last Saturday morning totally destroyed four trame buildings in Aneta and for a time a large part of the business district was threatened with destruction.

H. L. Moulton owned two of the burned buildings one of which was occupied by the Moulton poolroom and the other by the Aneta Athletic club as a gymnasium.

The other two buildings belonged to C. H. Stevens. One of the latter was occupied by Hoff's barber shop and the other was empty.

The loss on Moulton's buildings and their contents will amount to \$4,000, and the loss on the two Steven's buildings and the contents of the burber shop

amounts to \$2,000.

The loss of \$6,000 is about balf covered by insurance,
