

Work on the railroad well is progressing at the rate of about 3 feet per day and the indications are that it will be finished some day next week. The wind mill is on the grounds and as soon as the well is sufficiently deep its 60 foot tower and 18 foot wheel will be hoisted into position and then the carpenters will all be put to work on the large water tank. A long passing track has been placed between the main line and the elevator track. It is not yet completed but will be in the near future. The old depot has been raised upon piling and is resting easely until Sunday when an extra work train will come up the branch and load the depot on flat cars and take it to Mose for the benefit of the good people of that vicinity.
