

At a meeting of the school board last week the matter of a heating plant for the school house was discussed pro and con. The board decided on putting in a hot water system. O. S. Gunderson and Plumber Herlick were instructed to go to Wheatland, where they have a school building on much the same plans as that of our own, and has a heating plant. The Wheatland school is equipped with a steam heat system. The Binford contingent were informed that a steam heat system would be the more practical way of heating. Bids will printed shortly. The old stove system has not been satisfactory. With such a large basement the floor on the upper rooms were nearly impossible to get warm. When the heating plant is installed it will do away with that unpleasant feature besides it is expected that the fuel bill will be less.
