

A LOCAL FIRM GETS CONTRACT

**Greenland, Pritz & Co. Were
Awarded Contract for In-
stalling Heating Plant.**

Bids for the installation of a steam heating plant in the Binford school were opened Monday evening at the president's office.

The plans and specifications had been drawn up by T. P. Riley of Fargo. Three bids were received by the board from the following parties: Greenland, Pritz & Co., Binford, \$834.00; Valley City Heating & Plumbing Co., Valley City, \$980.00; T. P. Riley, Fargo, \$1092.00. It will be seen that the bid of the local concern is \$146 less than next lowest. The people of Binford should feel greatly satisfied that a home enterprise were the successful bidders and at such a much more nominal price.

The plans call for a 1950 foot boiler, with 4 inch mains leading to four rooms. Radiators will be placed in only the two front rooms, but the work will be so near completed that when it becomes necessary the other rooms can be heated with the attachment of the radiators. Three radiators are to be placed in each room and an extra stub for a fourth one should it be needed. Work will be commenced as soon as the material arrives.
