

NOTICE OF SCHOOL MEETING.

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday the 23rd day of July, A. D. 1907, there will be held a meeting at the school house in the Village of Binford of the voters residing on sections 5, 6, 7 and 8, in Addie school district No. 19; on the same day and date there will be held a meeting, at the Thorn school house, of the voters in the balance of said school district.

These meetings are called for the purpose of determining upon the question of dividing said school district of Addie into two school districts, as follows, to wit: The first district to be known as the Special School District of Binford, and to include the incorporated village of Binford, together with the balance of sections 8 and all of sections 5, 6 and 7, in Township 147, Range 60. The second district to be known as Addie School District No. 19, and to include all that part of the present Addie School District No. 19, not mentioned in the above named first district.

The terms of said division to be as follows: The first named district to have and to own the school house now located in the village of Binford together with the site upon which it stands, and all books, furniture and apparatus contained therein; the balance of the school district property to be held by the second named district; and all funds now belonging to the present district to be divided pro rata according to the assessed valuation of 1907.

The meetings will begin at 2 o'clock p. m. and close at 5 o'clock p. m. of said day.
