

FIRE DESTROYS JESSIE ELEVATOR

**Great Western Totally Destroyed
Tuesday Morning—Some
Grain Saved.**

An early morning fire Tuesday destroyed the Great Western elevator at Jessie. The origin of the fire is unknown.

The fire was discovered about 4:00 o'clock by the Dusbabek family. They gave the alarm to the central girl and in a short time the alarm became general.

It had gained such headway at the time of the discovery that it was useless to try to save it. The attention of the fire-fighters was turned to saving other buildings.

About 30,000 bushels of grain were in the house—mostly all wheat. The elevator is valued at \$6,000. There will be some salvage on the wheat.
