

McVile, N. D., April 7—This place was thrown into considerable excitement Sunday night by the report of an accidental shooting affair at the Larson farm three miles west of town.

Two sons of O. H. Larson, county commissioner of this district of Nelson county and a prominent business man of this place, were victims of the accident. One of the boys, about 12 years old, pointed a 38 caliber revolver at his brother, aged about 17 years, pulled the trigger and shot the lad through the neck, the bullet lodging, it is supposed, in the backbone, causing paralysis, from which the doctor gives no hopes of recovery.

After shooting his brother, the young lad became excited and accidentally shot himself in the knee, which also proved very painful. The parents and near relatives are prostrated over the affair. Another case of didn't know it was loaded.
