

LIGHTNING SET FIRE.

C. Marson's Barn, Horses, Colts, Chickens and Other Property Burned.

Sentinel: Lightning struck C. Marson's large barn on the farm south of town during the storm last Saturday evening, and it burned to the ground. Two horses, two colts, about one hundred chickens, fifty dollars worth of hay, a load of feed and all the harnesses were also burned.

The barn was 38x48 feet in size. The loss is estimated at \$1500 and there was no insurance.

The loss is a heavy one, but fortunately Mr. Marson is so situated that he can rebuild and replace everything at once.
