

Northwood Gleaner: (M. V. Linwell, president of the school board of the Northwood city school, who recently returned from an extended trip through Europe and the holy land has made the school another gift, this time in the form of four drinking fountains. These fountains do away with the objectionable common drinking cup. They are of the intermittent flow type, the foot being placed on a treadle to start the flow of water, which bubbles upward, the scholar drinking directly from the jet of water. With such an arrangement the lips never touch the metal of the fountain. A tank above the fountain furnishes the pressure to operate them. Northwood is the second or third school in the state to install bubble drinking fountains.
