

# GRIGGS COUNTY PIONEER DEAD

**Hon. David Bartlett, of Cooperstown, Died Last Thursday in Boston, Mass.**

Hon. David Bartlett, for 30 years a resident of the city Cooperstown and the state, former lieutenant-governor and a member of the constitutional convention where he was one of the forces which caused the prohibition plank to be inserted in the instrument, died Thursday at the home of his sister-in-law in Boston, Mass. He was stricken with a hemorrhage of the brain last month and went East to consult specialists, but had another severe attack soon after he arrived in Boston.

Bartlett was a pioneer of Griggs county. He served as lieutenant-governor of the state six years and in his home town was prominent in business and social circles. For several years he was state's attorney for Griggs county and his term of office was noted for the relentless war of the prohibition law. He was a thirty third degree Mason.
