

STATE SENATOR HELGELAND DEAD

Brother of O. S. Helgeland of
This Village Died Last Week
Following an Operation.

Sen. L. S. Helgeland of McVille died at the hospital in Northwood, Thursday morning at 7:30 o'clock. Senator Helgeland died from rupture of the stomach. Sunday night, Nov. 23, he was suddenly taken ill and the following morning was taken to Northwood for an operation. The patient withstood the shock nicely and up until last night he showed every indication that he was going to recover completely, but a sudden turn for the worse resulted in his death Thursday morning.

Mr. Helgeland was 55 years old last month, a prosperous farmer of Nesheim township, Nelson county. He was a married man with a wife and six children. He has held the position of county commissioner for two terms, served on the township board as school officer and at the last general election was elected state senator on the republican ticket for the Seventh legislative district, Nelson county.

His death will leave Nelson county without a state senator until election next fall. He was elected in 1912 to serve four years.
