

Four business buildings at Aneta were totally destroyed in a fire which started Wednesday afternoon at 4 o'clock in Jim Miller's confectionery store. By six o'clock the four structures had been leveled to the ground. The cause of the fire was a broken connection on the gasoline pressure tank of the lighting plant. A desperate fight by the firemen was necessary to save the postoffice building. This was the sixth time it has been in danger of burning but for some reason has always been saved.
