

LOCAL BALL TEAM HAS DISBANDED

Twenty-Six Games Played—Fifteen are Victories and Eleven Losses.

The "official" closing of the base ball season for the locals occurred last Sunday with the game with Pekin.

Out of the 26 games played, 15 have been won and 11 lost. This figures up for an average of .577, and while this is not an unsatisfactory record, still it is not up to the usual standard of teams representing Binford.

In reviewing the games of the season many pleasant memories are recalled—and then there are some which are not so pleasant. Of course, it must be admitted that the opposing teams in this section were stronger this year than last, and that we were not as strong, but, nevertheless, at least some of the defeats must be attributed to indifferent pitching. On the other hand, the fielding has been directly responsible for a few of the losses while, the others were lost because we had no "license" to win them.

It must be admitted, too, that there has been more or less internal dissention on the team, and this does not work well on any ball club.

There is still another unpleasant feature in reviewing the past season, and, perhaps, that has more to do with the future prospects for baseball in Binford than any other one thing. There is a deficit in the treasury, and Manager Boeckman has gone down into his own pockets to clean up the shortage. Something should be done to reimburse him for the money laid out and if this is done, Binford can be assured of a good team next season.
