

# WILL OPEN FOR BUSINESS SOON

Farmers' Co-Operative Company  
Have Decided to Put in  
Stock of Goods.

If the plans discussed at the meeting of the Bifford Co-operative company held last Friday, materialize, and it seems certain that it will, the company will put in a stock of goods shortly after the first of the year.

Another meeting of the directors is called for tomorrow to make the transfer of the opera house property, and then a meeting of the stockholders will be held later to settle the matter of opening the store. The bone of contention so far has been as to whether a stock should be put in the opera house annex, to start with, or whether the opera house proper should be used for that purpose. It is for that that a stockholders' meeting is called.
