

GOOD SPEAKERS COMING

Farmers' Institute Next Week Will be Big Event In
Binford. Good Program is Arranged.
Will Take Care of Crowds.

The committee arranging for the institute meetings to be held in Binford next Wednesday and Thursday have about completed their labors and from expressions made by the farmers, there is going to be a big time here on the two days.

Hoverstad, Prof. Shaw, recognized as one of the best authorities on agriculture in the northwest, and Prof. W. C. Palmer the agricultural editor. All of these men understand farming thoroughly and their advice will be appreciated by the farmers. Arrangements have been made by the committee to have sleeping quarters for those who want to remain over night and cannot get rooms at the hotel. Everything is being done to entertain you and keep you comfortable during the two days, so do not let anything keep you away from Binford on Wednesday and Thursday, Feb. 28-29.
