n Beginning Monday, July 1st, every y rural mail carrier in the United е. States began the delivery of mail ١t parcels hitherto exempt from delivg ery. This new 'parcels post' ruling d was recently made by the postmaster general. At present the ruling ıd will increase only the work of the ρf rural carriers. Under the new sysst tem all fourth class matter weighing a under 11 pounds will be delivered on nthe rural routes. The maximum cost ot for the delivery of an 11 lb. package e. will be 25c. As there is no difference in made in the charge of varying disntances, it will be much cheaper to ssend packages by mail instead of by st express. The postmasters receive 25 instructions to receive delivery to 2 and all rural carriers all packages re not prohibited in the mails and carou riers shall pick up all packages on ke their routes that come under this th rule. Postage shall be paid at the hrate of one cent for each two ounces et and under, two cents for more than ee two ounces and in no case to exceed 25c for the 11 pound package.
