

Postmaster Lewis has forwarded to Washington a petition signed by 54 patrons for a third rural route out of this place. The route, if established, will serve 200 people or more. Leaving the postoffice, the proposed route will go north $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, east $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, north 5 miles, west $1\frac{1}{2}$ mile, east $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, north 1 mile, east 3 miles, south 2 miles, east 2 miles, south 3 miles, west 4 miles, south 1 mile, west $\frac{1}{2}$ mile, south to postoffice. It is 25 miles long and will be served daily. Application has also been made for daily service on route number one.
