

Chas. Burgess, of the Rumely company, was here this week. The Rumely people are selling the Warner's Automatic Electric Light and Power systems, and they are making special efforts to install these plants in the towns, in addition to individual plants on the farms. From what information Mr. Burgess was able to furnish the proposition is one that should be looked into. A 1000-lamp system cost \$2525, a 750-lamp cost \$1975, and 500-lamp system cost \$1750. This is the price installed, and includes engine, dynamo, storage battery and automatic electrical switch board. The Warner system is on the order of the systems used in the towns up on the Great Northern, the difference being that the Warner is the only plant which is completely automatic to the point of starting and stopping the engine without the aid of the human hand. Mr. Burgess informed The Times that several of the towns around here are considering the installation of these plants.
