

NEW COUNCIL HAD MEETING

J. R. Truscott Was Elected Chair- man—Bonds Were Approved.

The first meeting of the new village board was held Tuesday evening in the First National bank.

Aldermen Evers, Truscott and Pritz were present.

The minutes of the meeting are as follows:

On motion made, seconded and carried, J. R. Truscott was elected chairman.

The oaths of office of Truscott, Pritz and Evers were filed with the clerk.

On motion the following bonds were approved:

Oscar Greenland, treasurer, \$2000, with Jos. Buchheit and John Knapp as sureties.

I. I. Braaten, clerk, \$300, with Andrew Dahlin and Albert Alfson as sureties.

Theo. Smogard, assessor, \$500, with Peter P. Idsvoog and O. G. Arneson as sureties.

L. P. Larson, justice of the peace, \$500, with A. J. Anderson and Theo. Smogard as sureties,

Ludvig Amundson, constable, \$500, with J. C. Thingelstad and J. A. Knapp as sureties.

On motion the bill of I. I. Braaten of \$2.50 for filing bonds was allowed.

On motion by Pritz, seconded by Evers, the board ordered that the following sums of money be raised by tax on taxable property in the village of Binford for the current year for the following purposes to-wit:

For general village purpose \$1200.

For road purpose, (5 mills.)

On motion O. K. Krogfoss was appointed pound master for the ensuing year.
