For the year 1912 there are 225 automobiles and 7 motor cycles registered in Griggs county. The license fee being \$3.00 for each machine, amounts to \$696.90. Of this amount the Secretary of State has retained \$187.80 as this county's share of the cost of tags and other expenses, leaving a balance of \$558.20 which has been turned into the county treasury where it is kept as a separate fund to be used for the im- b provement ot highways in such town- it ships as levied a tax of 6 mills or r more for road purposes in the cur- f rent year.
