

The Gudmunson brothers, who left here early last spring for Rye-gate, Montana, have been having more than their share of hard luck, according to a letter received here by J. C. Thinglestad. The boys have been running a steam plowing outfit out there and have had a lot of trouble and expense with their engine, on account of leaking flues, etc. They sold the outfit, the purchaser to take possession October 1st. On the 7th of this month they were out breaking and closed down for dinner. They had barely seated themselves at the table when the water hauler came in and told them that the engine was moving. The engine turned completely around and went over an embankment, a distance of 160 feet to the bottom. It was damaged practically beyond repair.
