

## TWO INJURED

### Tolna Residents Suffer Painful Injuries From Mishap.

Tolna seems to be the mecca for accidents.

Last week two serious mishaps occurred. The little 8-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Steve Allen, living south of Tolna, received a knife wound in his right eye that will probably cause the total loss of the eye. While cutting a band on a bundle of corn the knife slipped and flew from his hand, the blade entering his eye.

Last week Martin G. Jacobson, manager of the Tolna Farmers' Elevator company, met with a distressing mishap which cost him his right hand while grinding feed at the elevator.

The company conducts a feed mill in conjunction with elevator, and while grinding feed a small stone got into the rollers and stopped the machine. Mr. Jacobson reached into the hopper with his gloved hand and in removing the obstruction the machine immediately started, catching his hand and so smashing it that the doctor was compelled to remove the the injured member above the wrist.
