

FOUR INJURED

Auto and Buggy Meet—One Woman Perhaps Fatally Hurt.

The following account of the accident which seriously injured Mrs. Frank Myer, of Fairmount, this state, was taken from the Fargo Courier News:

"Four persons were injured in an automobile accident near the Great Northern station at Fairmount.

"While driving home with his wife and child, the carriage of Frank Myer, a grain buyer, was run into by an automobile driven by a farmer named Schroeder, who was attempting to pass. The vehicles became entangled and the occupants were thrown out.

"Mrs. Myer was pinned under the machine and sustained injuries that may prove fatal. Miss Bessie Mead, who was in the automobile, was also severely injured. The horse received a broken leg and was shot. The carriage was wrecked and the machine badly damaged."

The Myer's referred to are former residents of this vicinity, Mrs. Myers being a sister of Boyd Knapp. Mr. Knapp was summoned to Fairmount last week on account of his sister's injury. At last reports she is improving slowly, but is not out of danger.
