Large, New Barn of Norman McCulloch's Nearly Completed.

What is perhaps the largest and most substantial barn in Griggs county, is nearing completion on the Norman McCulloch farm, at Lake Jessie.

The building, which is an ell shape, is 105 feet long one way and 42 the other, with hay loft over each part. The floor is constructed of concrete and so laid to afford excellent drainage and easy to clean. Without crowding, the barn will hold 65 head of stock, and it will be equipped with all the modern devices to facilitate the work.

In addition, a large silo will be erected in the corner of the ell.

All the construction work and painting is being done by Binford workmen, O. O. Brodshaug and crew doing the carpenter work, and Linse & Simons the painting.
