McHenry People Are Not Satisfied With New Train Schedule.

McHenry Tribune: A new time card has been issued by the Northern Pacific which materially changes the time of departure of the branch line passenger. The daily train now arrives at 1:35, the same as before, but instead of leaving at 2 o'clock remains here until 3:50. Just why this change is being made is more than we are able to understand, as it in no way benefits the town or our citizens. Heretofore it was possible for passengers west of Hannaford to make a change at that point and take the Great Northern in to Fargo, arriving there at 7:30, but according to the present schedule passengers will be forced to go to Sanborn to catch the main line train and will be unable to reach Fargo until 9:30. But the "powers that be" have deemed it necessary to give us this service (?) and all we can do is to take our medicine. Great dissatisfaction is heard all along the line and it is possible that an effort will be made to make a change whereby we will be given at least a little consideration.
