on one motor cycle, a little east of Pekin. The cycle turned out of the road, and apparently ample space was allowed for the two to pass, but in some unaccountable manner the cycle'swerved into the road just at the moment of passing, the automobile striking the cycle, throwing both the riders in the air. Mr. Nesseth it seems was unhurt, while Mr. Ronningen struck the rear mud shield of the automobile, and received a severe gash in the head. He was at once taken to McVille, where Dr. Arneson dressed the wound, and at present he is reported as doing very well.
