He ran to Maurer's hotel to give the alarm and returned with a fire extinguisher, Mr. Maurer going to the fire hall to ring the alarm, and before the chemical engine arrived at the scene, the fire t extinguisher, which is often underd | estimated, had done the business. n It was a lucky blaze, and had it not been for the quick action and pres-, with the possible exc i-tion of the First State, bank, have been consumed.
