sheriff arrested young Sperry and took him to Grand Forks Friday morning for safe keeping. The complaint is issued at the instance of the attorney general's office, and the preliminary hearing was held before Police Mag-

This new turn of affairs has caused a great deal of excitement around this section of the state, almost as much as was first aroused over the burning of the little boy a year ago.

Sperry is the boy whom States
Attorney Skulason sard confessed that he and Louis Summerfield were implicated in the burning of the McKenzie boy, but
who refused to so testify at the
bearing of the case against Summerfield, who was acquitted of
