

Sutton Reporter: At last the telephone situation has been adjusted and a new service will be inaugurated Monday, June 2. A working agreement between the Hannaford-Dazey and Griggs county companies has been reached whereby the former company will have charge of the telephone business in Sutton and the territory tributary to it for a period of two years. The free service to other points which has been given by each company will be discontinued and a small toll will be charged hereafter. This arrangement will relieve the people here of the burden of renting two phones in order to get the service they want, and it will doubtless bring about an improved service generally.
