Levi Hiram Carpenter was born at Colesburg, Deleware county, Ia., November 14, 1852, and died at his home in Clearfield township, February 3rd, 1917, after an illness of about three weeks.

Mr. Carpenter lived in Iowa until 1898 when he moved to Wadena county, Minnesota. From there he came to Binford and has been a resident of Griggs county for the past ten years.

In 1883 Mr. Carpenter was married to Miss Edwina Brooks of Fayette county, Iowa.
