

Olaf Swenson Dead.

Olaf Swenson was born in Jerna Soden, Dalarna, Sweden, September 26, 1841. He was united in marriage in the year 1866 to Miss Christina Perjols of the same place. In the year 1870 he and his wife came to America and settled in Lake Lillian township, Kandiyohi county, Minnesota, where they remained until 1899. Thence they moved to Olivia, Minn.

To this union there was born three girls and two boys, of whom Andrew Swenson is the only surviving one, Mrs. Swenson being called to her home beyond in 1907. At this date Mr. Swenson came to Dakota and has since made his home with his son, Andrew, of this place.

In May, last year, Mr. Swenson suffered a stroke of paralysis, from which he never recovered. His death occurred last Friday, Feb. 4.

Deceased was an ardent and earnest member of the Swedish Lutheran church of Olivia, Minnesota. He was 74 years, 4 months and 9 days old, and leaves to mourn his death one son, Andrew, his wife and their daughter, Florence.

Funeral services were held at Andrew Swenson's home, Sunday, Feb. 6, and interment made in the Binford cemetery. Rev. P. Parks officiated at the funeral.
