Office Rooms in Ford Building—Modern Equipment is Being Installed.

The most important of the equipment is a Ritter electric engine, an electric sterilizer and electric lathe. The chair, bench, supply cabinet and a Synthetic porcelain cabinet are all finished in mahogany and make a very attractive appearance.
