

CHILDREN CROWD IN POSTOFFICE

Several Complaints Are Heard of
Children in Postoffice
at Mail Time.

Considerable complaint is heard about children in the lobby of the postoffice during the time that the mail is being distributed. On some occasions there are so many children about that it is almost impossible for one to get their mail.
