

FIRST DRIVE IS FINISHED

Over \$1000 Is Contributed to Red Cross Society in Binford.

The Binford branch of the Griggs county Chapter of the American Red Cross has completed their first drive for members and war fund contributions and we can proudly state that there isn't a slacker in the town.

An even hundred has been enrolled as annual and subscribing members, making a total of \$123 derived from memberships alone. Fifty cents of each membership fee will be retained by the local branch for supplies, and with this \$50 and another \$50 which was contributed by L. P. Larson to the supplies committee, the ladies will have a nice sum for which to purchase necessary material to begin their work.

The finance committee is to be commended for their part in the movement. Binford's portion of the \$1000 to be raised in Griggs county for the Red Cross war fund, was placed at \$600, but this amount was exceeded by \$300. Together with the amount collected for membership dues, over \$1000 has been contributed in Binford—or over \$3.00 per capita of the village's population.
