

A bridge and construction gang arrived here last week from Fargo and already have begun work on the erection of an engine house in which a gasoline engine to be used in pumping water for railroad purposes, will be installed. The new house will be a brick structure; 12x12, and will be modern in its construction. The old wind-mill which for years has furnished motive power for water purposes has proven inadequate for further use and as soon as the new pump station is completed will be torn down. In addition to erecting this new project, the same force of men will put a new flooring in the depot waiting room; also repair the loading platform and re-timber the railroad bridge west of town. Altogether the railroad improvements contemplated here will take about a month.
