## PHONE CASE TO BE HEARD

Railroad Commissioners Will Meet With Rural Telephone Co. in Binford in May.

An important point in laws enacted by the recent legislative assembly for the regulation of telephone companies is involved in a petition from the Farmers' Rural Telephone Co. of Binford for permission to install exchanges at Binford and Jessie, and which will call the railroad commission to Binford for a hearing May 15.

The exchange at Jessie was recently withdrawn, but there is an exchange at Binford, and there are rural lines at both points. The present laws prohibiting the duplication of telephone service govern such cases as these very specifically, but the Binford line evidently expects to prove to the commission that its case is exceptional.
